Increased responsibility

- **Taking ownership – personal responsibility for self and others**
- **Doing things more independently**
- **Looking after their things and those of others**
- **Applying and motivating themselves**

It might look like this:

- **Listening to teachers and others**
- **Talking loudly and confidently when presenting**
- **Sharing ideas and resources**
- **Teamwork**

Combining life at home with life at school

- **Love of reading – rewarding, valued**
- **Short but regular learning of spellings**
- **Play inside and outside – offline as much as possible**
- **Family games, chats, tv, trips out**
- **Sleep routines**

Agreed rules and routines

- **Discuss and set rules that shouldn't be challenged**
- **Make sanctions known, manageable and apply firmly**
- **Avoid being drawn into too much talking about a sanction so you're not lead into an argument.**
- **Discuss things with school if you would like help with home issues so children see us all as a team.**
- **Keep to routines yourself so they don't slide.**

Care, nurture, encouragement and expectations

- **Shared hopes**
- **Shared values**
- **Shared trust**
- **Shared aspirations**

- We help children to understand what is right
- We help them to reflect on mistakes - to put them right and avoid them happening again
- We create support session/groups for pupils when they need it
- We offer specialised support for pupils who experience difficulties with behaviour or work
- Our classrooms are nurturing and inclusive – fostering a family feel.
- Staff care deeply and go the extra mile to support and develop children
- We want to have good communication with you
- Never approach another child or their parents/carers yourself if you are unhappy about anything. Let us know and trust us to resolve issues.
